
The Amsterdam Metropolitan Area (AMA):

32% of all private sector jobs are created by international businesses: approximately


250,000 direct jobs and 250,000 indirect jobs

Highly skilled migrants mostly come from the EU (e.g. Germany (7%) France (6%)) and India (9%) **Great Britain (9%) US (4%)** 




of highly skilled migrants who arrived in 2014 remained economically active in the region for five years or longer
